



13th sitting of the Sejm, 9–11 March 2016

The Sejm passed the acts

- amending the Code of Penal Procedure and some related acts;
- amending the Penal Code and the Penal Execution Code;
- amending the act on the Bank Guarantee Fund;
- amending the act on payments within the direct aid systems and some related acts;
- amending the act on forests and the act on environment protection;
- amending the act on the system of animal identification and registration;
- on the trading safety of explosives precursors;
- ratifying the Agreement for the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank, drawn up in Beijing on 29 June 2015.

The Sejm referred to committees

- Government bill on withholding the property sales of the Agricultural Property Stock of the State Treasury and some related acts (the motion to reject the bill in the first reading was not accepted);
- Government bill amending the act on the public blood service and some related acts (a motion to additionally refer the bill to the Digitalisation, Innovation and Modern Technologies Committee shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm);
- Government bill amending the act on explosive materials intended for civilian use and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on the National School of the Judiciary and Prosecution Service and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the act which itself amended the Code of Civil Procedure and some related acts,

the act which itself amended the Civil Code, the Code of Civil Procedure and some related acts, the act on tax administration and some related acts.

The Sejm returned to a committee the Deputies' draft resolutions concerning the immigration policy of the Polish State at the European Union forum and Poland's immigration policy.

The Sejm adopted resolutions

- honouring the 100th anniversary of the birth of Maria Mirecka-Loryś – a steadfast hero of the independent Polish State;
- honouring the memory of the Good Maharaja;
- concerning the release of Nadia Savchenko;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

The Sejm accepted

- “Report on the realisation of the National Domestic Violence Counteraction Programme for the years 2014–2020 in the period between 1 January and 31 December 2014” submitted by the Council of Ministers;
- “Report on the realisation of the Act of 4 February 2011 on custody of the children below three years of age in 2014” submitted by the Council of Ministers;
- “Report on the state of the Polish language protection in the years 2012–2013” submitted by the Polish Language Council.

The Sejm received the Government's current information on the effects of the penal procedure reform.
