

## 17<sup>th</sup> sitting of the Sejm, 26–28 JUNE 2012

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the Law on assemblies;
- amending the act on occupational and social rehabilitation and on the employment of disabled persons, as well as amending some related acts;
- on reimbursement of particular unpaid entrepreneur dues, resulting from the realisation of commissioned public procurement;
- amending the act on renaming the Silesian Piast Medical Academy in Wrocław as the Silesian Piast Medical University in Wrocław.

### THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning naming the National Stadium in Warsaw as the Kazimierz Górski National Stadium in Warsaw;
- concerning the report of the National Council of Radio Broadcasting and Television on its activities in 2011.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the act on the turnover of financial instruments and the act on public offer and terms for introducing financial instruments into the organised turnover system and on public companies (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on disclosing in real-estate registers the right of property of the State Treasury and local government units (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*).

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST AND SECOND READING the Deputies' bill amending the act on animal feed.

**THE SEJM ACCEPTED** the information of the Minister of Transport, Construction and Maritime Economy on the realisation of the act establishing a long-term Seashore Protection Programme in 2011 (*The motion to reject the information, submitted at the previous sitting, was not accepted*).

### THE SEJM WAS PRESENTED WITH

- information on the activity of the Human Rights Defender in 2011 with some remarks on observance of human and civil rights and freedoms;
- the information on the activity of the Commissioner for Children's Rights in 2011 including the remarks on the state of observance of children's rights.

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION** on the initiatives on the Ministry of Transport, Construction and Maritime Economy as regards the use of EU funds for the railway transport.

**THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING** the draft resolution summoning the Minister of Transport, Construction and Maritime Economy to undertake purposeful actions aimed at ensuring a secure functioning of companies-subcontractors to the enterprises realising public procurement, in particular, in the scope of the road and highway construction.
