

## 25<sup>th</sup> sitting of the Sejm, 7–9 November 2012

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending particular acts as regards the realisation of the Budget Act;
- amending the act on state aid in repaying of some housing credits, providing guarantee premiums and refunding of the disbursed guarantee premiums to the banks;
- amending the Labour Code and some related acts;
- on the remission of dues in the form of unpaid social security fees incurred by persons conducting non-agricultural business activity;
- amending the act on the real estate management;
- on seed production;
- amending the act on safety and life-saving in the mountains and organised skiing areas and the environment protection act;
- ratifying the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Presidency of the Community of Democracies concerning the Permanent Secretariat of the Community of Democracies, signed in Ulan Bator on 9 July 2012;
- ratifying the Framework Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Federal Republic of Germany on Transboundary Cooperation in Emergency Medical Services, signed in Warsaw on 21 December 2011.

### THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning the 70th anniversary of the establishment of the National Armed Forces;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees;
- concerning the appointment and the election of the personal composition of the Special Committee to consider the deregulatory bills.

### THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill on the reduction of particular administrative burdens within the economy;
- Government bill the management of packaging and packaging waste;
- Government bill amending the act regulating the practicing of particular professions;
- Citizens' bill on the common court circuits and amending the act on the system of common courts.

**THE SEJM RETURNED TO THE COMMITTEE** the Government bill amending the act on family benefits and some related acts.

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING

the Deputies' bill on the Commissioner for Family's Rights.

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

the Deputies' draft resolution concerning amending the Standing Orders of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland.

**THE SEJM ACCEPTED** information of the Prime Minister on the European policy.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED

- Government information on the plans for liquidation of some of the district courts;
- information for the Sejm and the Senate on the participation of the Republic of Poland in the works of the European Union in the period January–June 2012 (*The motions to reject the information shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION

on the entry into force on 1 January 2013 of the European Union climate and energy package.
