

35th sitting of the Sejm, 6–8 MARCH 2013

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on corporate savings and loan associations and some related acts;
- amending the act on the reimbursement of excise duty contained in the price of diesel oil used in the agricultural production;
- amending the act on protection of agricultural land and woodland.

THE SEJM ADOPTED THE RESOLUTION commemorating the anniversary of establishment of the Polish Socialist Party.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- on crop protection chemicals (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on spatial planning and order (*The Senate's amendment was accepted*);
- amending the act on public offer and terms for introducing financial instruments into the organized turnover system and on public companies, as well as amending some related acts (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- on payment due dates in commerce transactions (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the Labour Code and the act on trade unions;
- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code;
- Committee bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on excise duty;
- Government bill on the means of physical coercion and firearms;

- Deputies' bill on the Corps of Veterans of the Struggle for the Independence of the Republic of Poland.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code (*The motions to reject the bills shall be considered at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- information of the Minister relevant for education and upbringing on the state of preparations of governing authorities to subject six-year-old children to schooling duty (*The Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the information, submitted at the previous sitting*);
- report on the results of the act on public benefit and volunteer work in the years 2010 and 2011, submitted by the Council of Ministers.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the evaluation of actions undertaken by the government, aimed at reducing the extent and scope of poverty, particularly the poverty of families with children, numerous families, families with unemployed or disabled persons, and families with persons living off the social security benefits.

THE SEJM REJECTED the Deputies' motion to pass a vote of no confidence in the Council of Ministers managed by the Prime Minister Mr. Donald Tusk and appointing Mr. Piotr Tadeusz Gliński the Prime Minister.
