THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the Budget Act for 2013;
- Government bill amending the act which itself amended particular acts due to the realization of the Budget Act;
- Government bill on mutual help in executing taxes, customs duty and other monetary dues;
- Government bill amending the Pharmaceutical Law and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the act on organization of milk and dairy products market;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on commune government;
- Government bill amending the act on excise duty;
- Senate's bill amending the act on the Police and some related acts.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the Budget Act for 2013;

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- commemorating the 330th anniversary of the battle of Vienna;
- establishing 20 of September the National Pre-schooler Day;
- concerning the election of a new personal composition of the European Union Affairs Committee;
- concerning changes within personal composition of Sejm committees.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE SECOND READING

- Government bill amending the act on military service of professional soldiers and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on the Tribunal of State (*The vote on the motion to reject the bill was postponed to the next sitting of the Sejm.*)

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Government bill amending the Law on the system of common courts, the act on the National Council of the Judiciary and some related acts (*The vote on the motion to refer the bill to a committee was postponed to the next sitting of the Sejm.*);
- Senate's bill amending the act on personal income tax and the act on the freedom of business activity (*The vote was postponed to the next sitting of the Sejm.*);
- Deputies' bill on goods and services tax (*The vote on the motion to reject the bill was postponed to the next sitting of the Sejm.*)

THE SEJM CONSIDERED CURRENT INFORMATION on establishing a dialogue between the government and trade union organizations and on realization of postulates presented to the Marshal of the Sejm by leaders of Independent Self-governing Trade Union "Solidarity" (NSZZ "Solidarność"), All-Poland Alliance of Trade Unions (OPZZ) and Trade Unions Forum (FZZ).

- of the Council of Ministers on economic situation in Polish agriculture in the years 2005–2013, with reference to means of the EU funds for the development of rural areas, export of Polish agricultural products and foodstuffs, as well as the grain and rapeseed market;
- of the Prime Minister on the situation of young people in Poland;
- of the Prime Minister on government plans as regards the alarming financial situation of Polish enterprises and increase in enterprise insolvencies declared in 2012 and the first quarter of 2013.
