

59th SITTING OF THE SEJM, 22–24 JANUARY 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on principles for conducting the development policy and some related acts;
- amending the act on payments within direct aid systems;
- amending the act on the Agency for Restructurisation and Modernisation of Agriculture;
- amending the act on forests;
- amending the act on the Police, the act on the Border Guard, the act on the State Fire Service, the act on the Government Protection Bureau, the act on the Internal Security Agency and the Intelligence Agency, the act on the military service of professional soldiers, the act on the Central Anticorruption Bureau, the act on the service of the officials of the Military Counterintelligence Service and the Military Intelligence Service, the act on the Prison Service and some related acts;
- amending the act on the public prosecution service, the Law on the System of Common Courts and the act on the Supreme Court;
- amending the Law on the System of Common Courts;
- amending the Law on the System of Common Courts and some related acts;
- amending the Energy Law and some related acts;
- amending the Code of Penal Proceedings;
- amending the act on veterans and particular persons – victims of war and postwar repressions, and some related acts;
- on principles for public fundraising.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- honouring the memory of Wincenty Witos on the 140th anniversary of his birth;
- concerning the events in Ukraine;

- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- Budget Act for 2014 (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Labour Code (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on public benefit and volunteer work and some related acts (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Hunting Law (*The Senate's amendments were rejected*).

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- President of the Republic's bill amending the Law on Assemblies;
- Deputies' bill amending the Code of Civil Procedure;
- Deputies' bill amending the Electoral Code.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED the information of the Council of Ministers on the realization in 2012 of the Act of 9 June 2011 on supporting the family and the system of foster care (*The motion to reject the information shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting*).

THE SEJM REJECTED THE MOTION for a vote of no confidence in the Minister of Health Bartosz Arłukowicz.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the problem of doctor's sick notes submitted at physical education classes.
