

66th SITTING OF THE SEJM, 23–24 APRIL 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on reserves of petroleum, petroleum products and natural gas, as well as principles for proceeding in a situation of a threat to the State fuel security and disturbances in the petroleum market, as well as amending some related acts;
- amending the act on investments relating to the regasification terminal of liquefied natural gas in Świnoujście and the act on real estate management;
- amending the act on competition and consumer protections and the Code of Civil Procedure;
- amending the Water Law and some related acts;
- amending the act on national and ethnic minorities and on the regional language, as well as the act on departments of government administration;
- amending particular acts due to standardization of specific document patterns in administrative procedures;
- amending the act on quartering of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland;
- amending the act on toll motorways and the National Road Fund, and some related acts.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- honouring the blessed John Paul II, the Pope;
- honouring Jacek Kaczmarski on the 10th anniversary of his death;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the act on the universal duty to defend the Republic of Poland and some related acts (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on complementary supervision over credit institutions, insurance companies, rein-

surance companies and investment companies constituting parts of financial conglomerates and some related acts (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);

- amending the act on the system of education (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on railway transport, the act on commercialisation, restructurisation and privatisation of the public company Polish National Railways and the act on the Railway Fund (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on family benefits (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill on informing on prices of goods and services;
- Committee bill amending the act on vehicle drivers.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the Banking law and the Code of Civil Procedure;
- Government bill amending the act on the system of education and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill establishing the Polish Space Agency.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED the report of the Council of Ministers on the realisation the National Domestic Violence Counteraction Programme between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012 (*The Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the report, submitted at the 65th sitting*).

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING the Deputies' bill on sexual education.

Irena Tomaszak-Zesiuk took the Deputies' oath.
